


History of Tripkovic Palace

Tripkovic Palace was built at the end of the 18th century, and it represents one of the most imposing "captains" palaces in Boka Kotorska. In the course of the 18th century the Tripkovic family played an important role in the development of Dobrota, particularly in trade, in the building of a merchant marine fleet, and in architectural and cultural development. The family possessed 18 ships. In the 18th and 19th centuries there is mention of 86 seamen from this family, of which 63 were captains.

The Palace is set back from the coast and raised on a plateau which is supported by a huge retaining stone wall with a long balustrade; on top of the wall is a "djardin" (a garden). In the wall is the entrance portal with the family coat of arms. In front of the Palace is a harbour ("ponta") with a "mandrac" (a qay and an enclosure for boats) which belongs to the Palace.







Behind the Palace are terraced gardens.

The Palace is built with finely hewn stone of Korcula. Its interior was created in the Baroque style characteristic for the Eastern Adriatic.

The palace consists of four levels.

There is the ground level with the main entrance, behind which is an altar, flanked by a study and a small reception room. The first floor is the main living area, consisting of a large salon, a dining salon and a kitchen, and a bedroom.


The second floor is taken up by the master bedroom and two additinal bedrooms.

The third floor consists of a large salon with a fire place, and three bedrooms.

At the very top is a belvedere which is topped by a tower-like ornament.

The facade is dominated by a balcony resting on brackets decorated with motifs of acanthus leaves.







The Tripkovic Palce has been restored to its full glory.

You too can experience the spirit of the most splendid period in the history of Boka akotorska and become the host in the most monumental edifice in Europe's southernmost fjord.


